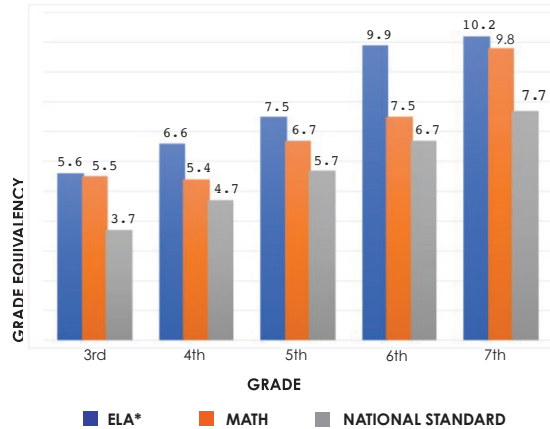


Academic Results

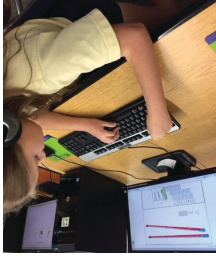

The Technology Program is fully integrated into the core curriculum. Our state-of-the-art technology lab has thirty work stations running Windows 10, iPad tablets are available for classrooms, and 2-in-1 laptop tablets are assigned 1:1 to Middle School students. Classes visit the lab at least once a week and are guided through lessons and activities with their classroom teacher and the Technology Coordinator.

Technology Program

Student instruction is based on literacy objectives for word processing, databases, graphic design, internet, spreadsheets, desktop publishing, multimedia, keyboarding, web page design and video/photo editing. Our goal is for all students to gain a working knowledge of computer operations and a vocabulary of computer related terminology through projects developed within the curriculum, and to use computers as a tool for productivity, communication, information, learning and creativity.
